- 1. Infection-control protocols and worker-preparedness plans at all health facilities.
- 2. Dedicated, specially trained teams of willing staff—including doctors, nurses, lab and X-ray technicians, and housekeeping staff—to care for potential Ebola patients. And there must be
  - adequate staffing.
- 3. Inclusion of frontline providers in the development and implementation of plans.

Remember, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration requires an Ebola preparedness plan at every facility.
