**Birdies for Charity is a pledge based fundraiser. Each donor will make a pledge for how many birdies they think will be made throughout the tournament (June 22-28). For example, if 1,500 birdies are made: 2 cents = \$30; 10 cents = \$150; \$1.00 = \$1500. There is a \$0.02 minimum donation per birdie or you can make a flat donation of your choosing.**
